We certainly did that once again, in typical Lithuanian tradition and fashion, on March 27. I remember looking out at the congregation and thinking how grateful I was to see so many of you attend and for the patience you demonstrated while the 10 AM English Mass departed the sacred space of St. Peter Lithuanian Church. I was grateful for all the youth that readily volunteered at Dr. Aldona Lingertat's request to help carry the traditional religious articles during the procession. I was grateful to see so many of the parish's young present and allowed by their parents to join in the procession. I was grateful to the choir led by Ms. Daiva Navickas and the Young at Heart Ensemble for adding the beautiful music. Monsignor Contons did his usual great job presiding at the liturgy. Davia did a wonderful job using her culinary skills to ensure that the kavute provided a place for people to gather after Mass and share their Easter joy.
