Dear Parishioners and Extended Family Members,

Garbė Jėzui Kristui! Praised be Jesus Christ!

As we emerge from the busiest month of St. Peter Lithuanian Parish, the month of May, we find ourselves being greeted by the first anniversary of the present arrangement between the parish and the Lithuanian Ethnic Apostolate, of which yours truly is the director of, although I prefer to refer to myself as chaplain. That date is June 2.

I would like to review with you what is different now. Daiva, the Apostolate's secretary, and I still sense that the arrangement is not clear to everyone.

First, St. Peter Lithuanian Parish remains just that. While the schedule is different and church building is used much more frequently, the parish is still the parish. The responsibility of the pastor, Fr. Stephen Madden, is to administer the parish and work side by side with me in administering the sacraments to you, the parishioners. My responsibility is to provide for you pastoral care as well as what I previously stated. So what are the mechanics of this?

Please remember that all ACTIVE records remain in possession of the parish. The PARISH must be contacted for copies of Baptismal, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage, and Death records listed in those books. INACTIVE parish records, records old enough to be considered archives, are in possession of the Lithuanian Apostolate at St. Elizabeth Rectory in Milton.

Scheduling of all church events must take place through the PARISH. This includes all baptisms, weddings, and funerals. Once it has been established that the church is available, then and only then is it appropriate to plan the celebration of any of these.

You are able to contact St. Peter Lithuanian Parish or the Lithuanian Ethnic Apostolate at the usual number, 617-268-0353. Please choose which option you would like when you are prompted to.

Please remember to support the parish, both in the weekly collection and in the grand annual. Active participants donating time, talent, and treasure, make up a strong community, not a bank account. It is up to you to make the most of the parish, no matter what the situation may be.

Finally, some of you have commented that the church is not being called St. Peter Lithuanian Church, but rather St. Peter Church. This is to ensure all feel welcome in this age of collaboration. The name of the parish remains St. Peter Lithuanian Parish. I remember when I first suggested that "Roman Catholic" be a part of our church's sign, it was not a welcomed idea. I explained that, as Roman Catholics, we are a church of 1.2 billion members. We are to be a welcoming community, as all Catholic communities are called to be. Let us willingly share all God has blessed us with through the parish. For no gift of God's is meant to be kept to one's self.
