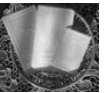

The Co-Directors of the Lithuanian Apostolate are Aldona Lingertat and Gloria Adomkaitis. Daiva Navickas continues as Administrative Assistant. Birute Banaitis, Mirga Girnius, Tomas Girnius, Gita Kupcinskas, and Dalia Zikas have graciously agreed to serve on the Apostolate Advisory Committee.

We look forward to continuing the mission of the Lithuanian Apostolate and sharing with you our vision for the future. Our principal goal is to reach out to members of the broader Lithuanian Community and invite them to attend and support the parish. By doing so, it is our hope that the parish will become stronger and flourish in the coming years.

As a first step in accomplishing our goals, a Children's mass is being planned for Sunday, December 9th, at 11:00 a.m. We are reaching out to members of the community with young children and are inviting them to participate in this mass designed especially for them. Traditionally, there will also be a communal Christmas Eve dinner in the parish hall after mass.
