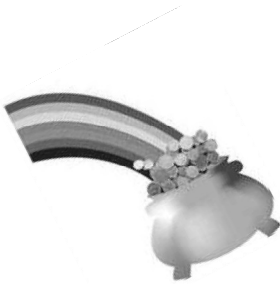

It has now been two months since our church's fire. Things are progressing slowly but surely. I expect the church to be "back to normal", with the exception of the stained glass windows, by Holy Week. We will be allowed to return to worship before then, but the space will still be a "work in progress."

Thank you to all who have contributed to The St. Peter Lithuanian Parish Fire Fund. I appreciate that there are demands being placed on you, both practically and from other charities. May God bless you in your generosity. It is very much appreciated. Your donations will not only help with fire related expenses, but also with projects that we wish to finance with the equipment already in place. This includes naming all the saints painted on our church's ceiling in Lithuanian and replacing all of the shutters in the church's bell towers, 14 in all. Both of these projects are too expensive without the staging and hydraulic lift already in place. They will now be done without these added expenses.

Thank you to the following parishes who contributed to our parish's fire fund: Sacred Heart Parish, Roslindale, St. Francis Xavier Parish, Weymouth, and St. John the Baptist Parish, Quincy. Their generosity demonstrates to us that we are truly members of the Body of Christ here in the Archdiocese of Boston.

PLEASE PRAY FOR THEIR PARISHIONERS.

It is literally impossible for me to imagine the Archdiocese being more cooperative and supportive with the rebuilding of the church. I am so grateful that I am still able to be your pastor in the midst of all the work that is taking place, instead of being buried in paper. Thank you to Mr. Gintaras Čepas, who has been my "Guardian Angel" through this whole process.

In conclusion, I ask you to please support two fund raisers:

1 – **THE PARISH LOTTERY**. It is part of our parish's operating budget. I ask you to support the parish and win one of four prizes, the top being \$10,000!!

2 – **THE CATHOLIC APPEAL** – Last year was the first time in four years we DID NOT reach our goal.
