Dear Parishioners and Extended Family Members,

Garbe Jėzui Kristui! Praised be Jesus Christ!

As I look out the window of the Lithuanian Apostolate office, I see both snow and signs of Spring determined to make themselves known since their season is only a month away.

March also means the beginning of Lent. Once again, I wish to express my deepest gratitude to Dr. Aldona Lingertat for leading / organizing the "Arise" groups of our parish so that the participants can truly enrich themselves during the Lenten season. It is wonderful to be given the opportunity to share your faith within the parish's community so you can be better prepared to share it with someone who is outside and looking for answers about Jesus Christ.

During the season of Lent, the Archdiocese will once again be promoting its "The Light is on for You" initiative in order to help people to get back to the sacrament of Reconciliation. Confessions will be heard in every church from 6:30 PM - 8 PM. Our preparation during Lent lends itself to us opening our minds and hearts to Christ through His Church in order to make him more the center, the focus of all that we think, say, and do. Admitting our guilt of sin and asking for God the Father's mercy means that we own up to our sins and recognize our dependence on God if we wish to change our ways to be more like Christ. Confession is a great place to start!

This sacrament will also be available during our parish's annual Day of Reflection. It will be Saturday, March 18. Confessions will be heard from 2 -4 PM and Lithuanian Mass will be celebrated at 4 PM. Kavute will be after Mass. (There will be no Lithuanian Mass on Sunday, March 19)

I must say that I continue to be flattered when comments are made regarding my absence when I am not celebrating Lithuanian Mass on Sunday. Please realize that a lot of planning goes in to the scheduling of Masses since both Monsignor and I have multiple obligations. When neither of us is able to cover Lithuanian Mass at St. Peter's, the Franciscans of Kennebunkport have been very generous in offering our community Father Aurelijus. While some of you may find this less than ideal, please remember to pray for an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life and actually encourage young men within the community to consider the priesthood.

Finally, while you have been waiting and / or making suggestions for certain changes to be made regarding the administration of St. Peter Lithuanian Parish, I continue to ask for your patience, especially as you welcome Fr. Jim Flavin as your new pastor this month. Greet him with open hearts and minds. You will be glad you did.
