As I write to you regarding the month of November, I do so having just celebrated Mission Sunday Mass at the Archdiocese's cathedral, The Cathedral of the Holy Cross. Our parish's choir was invited to sing the offertory hymn while His Eminence, Cardinal Sean, celebrated Mass. They did a wonderful job representing the parish and expressing how our community integrates expressions of its identity with its worship. Thank you and a job well done to Daiva Navickas and those who sang!

During November, the Month of All Souls, it has been brought to my attention that the parish could have a "phone chain," people assigned to call other parishioners to inform them of the death of a fellow parishioner. This would assure people of knowing about an upcoming funeral and more time to prepare for it. Please note the schedule changes listed on page two of this month's bulletin. There will be only one Christmas Eve Mass next month. This was scheduled with the belief that more people would attend. Last year's attendance for both Christmas Eve Masses would have filled one half of the church. We will evaluate this change after Christmas. The second change is no longer celebrating the 4 PM Mass on Saturdays after December 18, 2010. (Please see September's bulletin for the reasoning regarding this decision.)

Recently, representatives from all seven South Boston parishes met at St. Christopher Church at Harbor Point for supper and an exchange of ideas. This is in acknowledgement of the parishes' need to work together in order to sustain and grow the Catholic faith in South Boston. A spirit of cooperation was very much apparent and encouraged everyone who attended. This is the future of the church. It is already taking place within and outside the City of Boston and will be happening in South Boston soon.

Last, and certainly not least, you probably have seen / heard about the extensive renovation the face of our parish church is going through. This was brought to my attention during the severe storms of March. Please remember that the Building and Maintenance Fund Collection is not "just another collection." It is what keeps our worship space both safe and beautiful. Your support is essential to keep the building both safe and beautiful without having to engage in a major fund raising campaign.
