Information about the Petition Drive for Assisted Suicide

Between now and December 7th, supporters of a bill to legalize physician assisted suicide will be trying to gather 68,911 signatures from Massachusetts voters. This is the first step in putting this measure on the ballot in November, 2012. The position of the Church is that all suicide is a tragedy. In a recent homily, Cardinal Séan said, „A vote for assisted suicide is a vote for suicide.“ Please consider Church teaching if asked to sign the petition for this suicide initiative.

Dear Parishioners and Extended Family Members of Saint Peter Lithuanian Parish,

As we enter the second-to-last month of the year, it is time for both remembering and looking ahead.

The South Boston Choirs Concert on October 2 was a big success. Parishioners from all South Boston Parishes and St. Christopher's of Harbor Point gathered to hear all the participants sing. At the end, all choirs joined those in attendance singing "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name." It was wonderful for each parish choir to share its talent with the rest of the parishes of the local Collaborative. Our parish was represented by its own choir as well as the Young At Heart Ensemble, and very well may I add!!

November, of course, is All Souls Month. Tuesday is All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation, and November 2 is All Souls Day.
