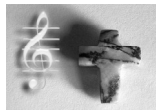

Garbe Jezui Kristui! Praised be Jesus Christ!

As I write you emerging from the summer months, I wish to alert you to developments, which will be coming about in the near future.

First, there is the New Roman Missal. This will be used beginning on the First Sunday of Lent on November 27, 2011. There will be new responses to be learned as a result. I wish to have one homily per month dedicated to the New Roman Missal during the English Mass in order to help us prepare for its arrival.

Second, President Obama, through the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, has mandated that birth control, including the types which terminate pregnancies in their earliest stages, are to be provided through all health care providers free of charge. While there is a claim that religious beliefs are honored, it is only within the religious belief. This means Catholic hospitals can neither hire someone nor medically assist someone if they are not Catholic. This offends Religious Freedom. There is a bill in Congress, Respect for Rights of Conscience Act of 2011, being submitted that protects Freedom of Conscience from this threat. It is H.R. 1179. Its purpose is to amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to protect rights of conscience with regard to requirements for coverage of specific items and services. (Namely, contraception and abortion.) Since you value the mission of the Catholic Church to provide health care on an unrestricted basis, please call your Representative to support this bill. Not being forced to discriminate who is assisted with health care is vital to our Catholic tradition, pride, and heritage!!

Third, it appears euthanasia will be on the Massachusetts 2012 ballot in the form of a question. PLEASE do not get sucked in by the rhetoric of "mercy killing." This bill not only robs suffering of its redemptive value through joining it to Jesus' by allowing a person to end their own life, but actually makes doctors, whose vow it is to help people live, agents of death through their consent. This is against church teaching and is not in any way to be considered a form of "mercy." Please plan to vote against this measure now and share this decision with those who will vote.

ALL life is to be considered sacred from the first moment of conception to the last moment of natural death. What life we don't protect now will have bearing on us personally as well as on all of humanity later.
