As you know, on October 9, at 2 p.m., there will be a Mass of Thanksgiving in the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception to mark the golden anniversary of the dedication of the Chapel of Our Lady of Siluva. Archbishop Joseph Kurtz, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, will be the principal celebrant and homilist. Joining him in celebrating the Mass will be Kaunas Archbishop Lionginas Virbalas, S.J. Four accomplished Lithuanian choirs – Dainava from Chicago, Exulatate from Cleveland, Laisvė from Philadelphia, and Volungė from Toronto, Canada – will sing at the Mass.
